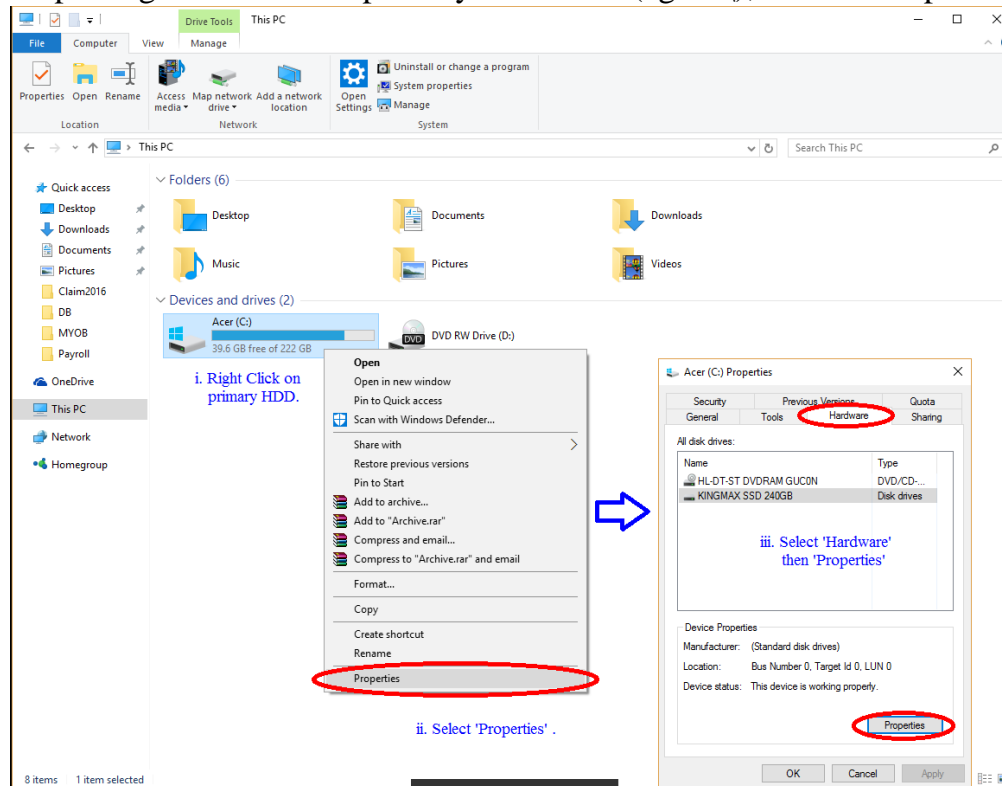


# Performance Improvement for Domain Controller service (Windows Server OS)

## Solution A (not recommended) :-

Step1. Right click on the primary Hard Disc (eg. C:\), click to Properties\Hardware \Properties.



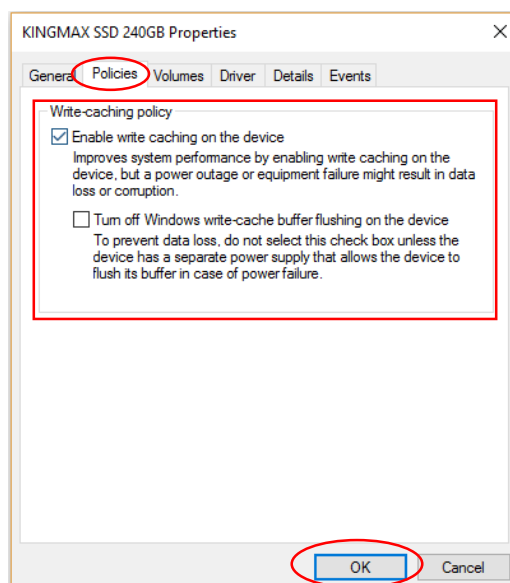
Step 2. Go to 'Policies' tab.

Step 3. Turn-ON 'Enable write caching on the device'.

Untick the 'Turn off Windows write-cache buffer flushing on the device'.

Step 4. Press OK to EXIT.

Follow Step 3.



## Solution B (Recommended) :-

Step 1. Add Physically new partition/ Hard Disc (let's said G:). Ensure the all FDB files stored in G:\ .

Step 2. Right click on the partition/ Hard Disc (eg. G:), click the Properties\Hardware \Properties.

Step 3. Go to 'Policies' tab.

Step 4. Turn-ON 'Enable write caching on the device'.

Untick the 'Turn off Windows write-cache buffer flushing on the device'.

Step 5. Press OK to EXIT.

**Follow Step 4.**
